Our team provides treatment for the following conditions:

- Cleft lip/palate

- Vascular malformation

We believe in addressing the condition as soon as it is the right time for the patient.

Many of these conditions are identified in utero, meaning reconstructive surgeries can be scheduled early, which has many benefits. While these benefits depend on the type of surgery, they can include minimizing speech problems and increasing weight gain due to ease of feeding, as well as improving the appearance of scars, as seen below.
